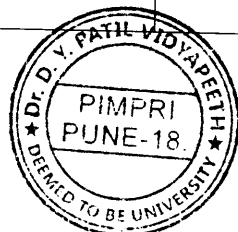

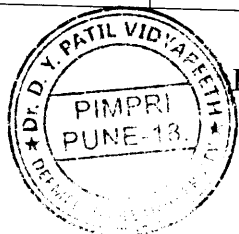
**Programme of Post Graduate Medical Degree (Regular) Examinations to be held in May - 2019**

- 5) The Theory Examinations will be held at Dr. D. Y. Patil Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Pimpri, Pune - 411018.

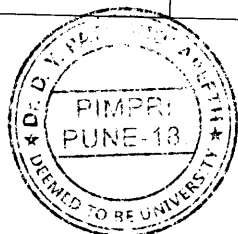

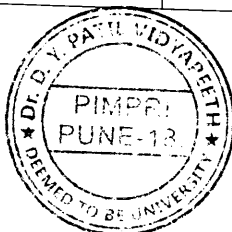

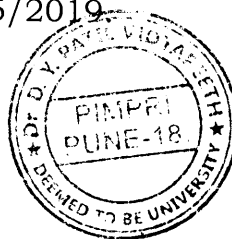
