Dear Students,

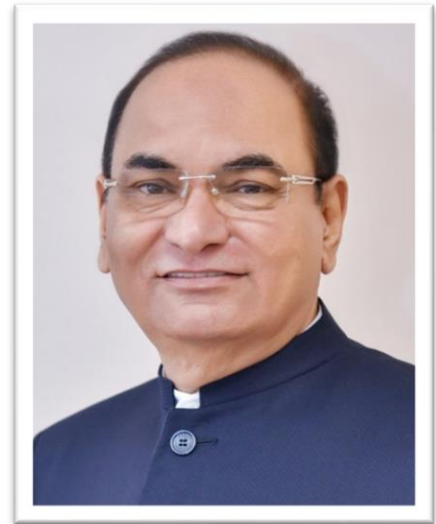

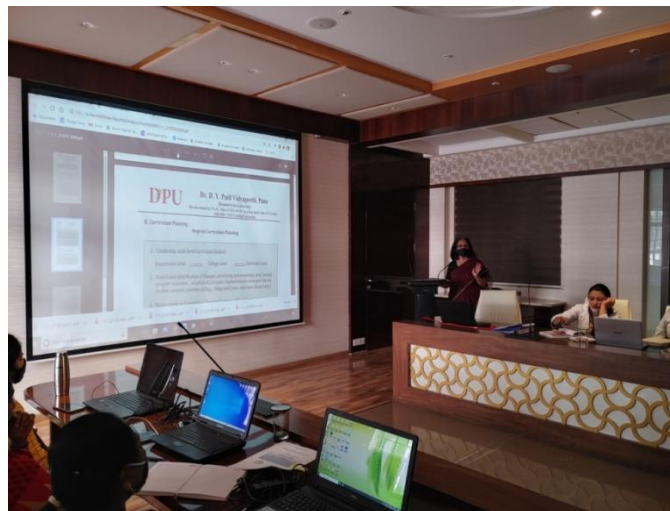

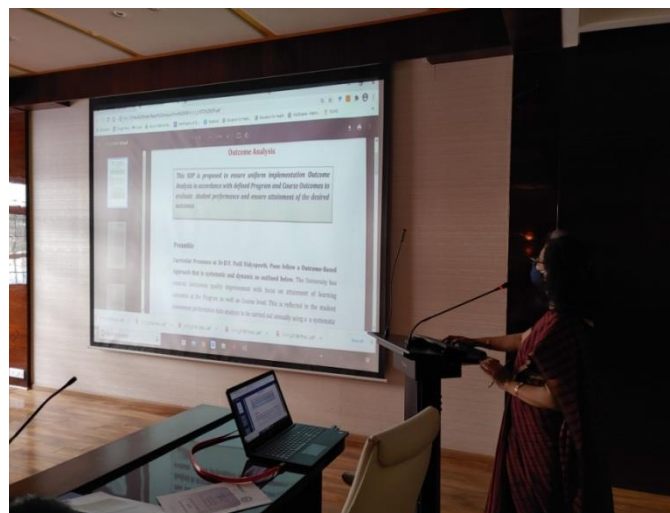

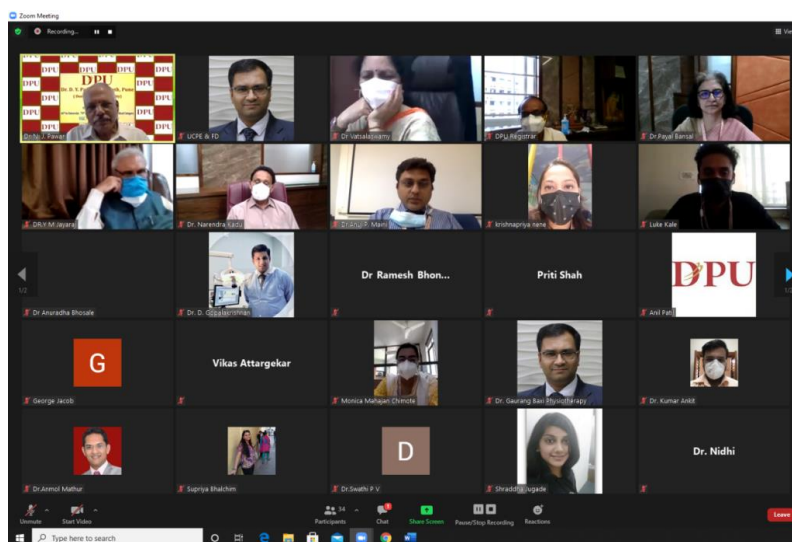
This workshop was specially designed for the Dental Faculty, and consisted of three modules:

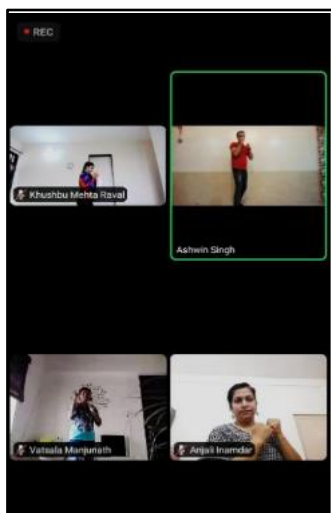

- **World No Tobacco Day**

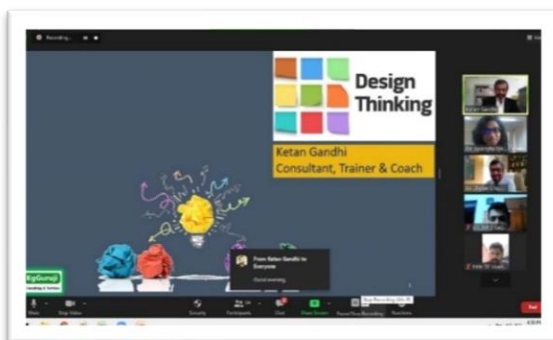
