






Chancellor's Message


Module 1: Constructive Alignment in Outcome based Education


Three weeks students induction program






National Webinar on "Panchakarma, Ayurveda and Astrology"


1. Fit India Freedom Run 2.0:




3. Fresher's Welcome:




4. Awareness program on avoiding the use of single-use plastics:

5. Gandhi Jayanti Celebration:



He was the first fellow of "Johnson and Johnson Gift of Sight International Fellowship programme" at the Boston Foundation for Sight, USA in 2003.

In response to Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam's appeal to NRI's and request of Dr. Badrinath and Dr. Gangadhara Sundar of Shankara Nethralaya and Dr. Santosh Honavar of L V Prasad Eye Institute, he came back to India and trained persons to be Ocularists and set up the laboratory for Ocularist Services.

He was the Director of Clinical Operations for Boston Foundation for Sight USA from 2004 till 2009. He offers Chandra Scleral lens for Sever Ocular Surface Disease like Steven Johnson Syndrome and graft Vs Host Disease. This prosthetic device can delay the need for corneal transplant in many Keratoconus patients. He offers services at Shekhar Eye Research with a motto of no qualified patients are refused due to their ability to pay for the treatment cost. He also manufactures contact lenses at Flexi Lens Pvt Ltd who makes world class lenses using CNC technology only of its kind in India.

Synthetic Cornea, Custom Artificial Eyes, Orthokeratology and Scleral Lenses and Diamond Studded contact lenses a patented technology are his major contributions in the field of Ophthalmology in India.

He narrated his highs and lows of life. While sharing his experiences he emphasized on the solutions more than the problem, which helped him overcome all his difficulties and achieve his goal.
