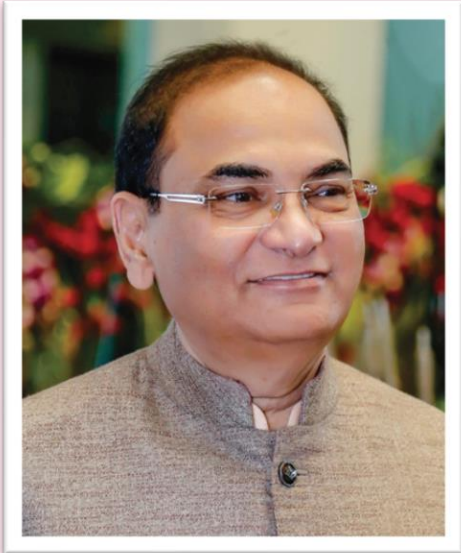

#### 2. Workshop on Fundamentals of Health Professions Education

No. of Participants trained: 24

A workshop on Fundamentals of Health Professions Education was conducted from 21<sup>st</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> November 2022 for faculty from constituent colleges of DPU. 24 participants from the constituent units of the Vidyapeeth participated in the training program. Dr. Suhasini Nagda, Former Director of ME and MH, (Mumbai), was the guest faculty for the workshop. Dr. Gaurang Baxi, Additional Director, UCPE and FD, along with other faculty from constituent units also contributed towards the program.

The workshop had multiple sessions on learning principles, curriculum, interactive teaching-learning methods, and newer assessment methods. To facilitate the online teaching skills of the participants, dedicated sessions on how to use IT and interactive online tools, as well as how to develop a lesson plan for blended learning were specially included as part of the workshop schedule.

## Dr. D. Y. Patil Vidyapeeth's Research and Development Cell

The research and development cell of Dr. D. Y. Patil Vidyapeeth is involved in various activities and has achieved several milestones in the second half of 2022. Some of the activities and achievements of the research and development cell include:

**Research Projects:** The various constituent units of the DPU received funds from various government and non-governmental organizations. These agencies include ICMR (30 lakhs), Gennova Biopharmaceuticals Limited CRO JSS Medical Research Asia (32.51 lakhs), LUPIN pharmaceuticals Pvt. Ltd. CRO- IQVIA (16.90) etc. Additionally, faculty members have applied to various external funding agencies during this period and the results are awaited. This funding has enabled the university to undertake more ambitious and impactful research projects.

**Publications:** Total publications by the end of 2022 is 1212. Some of the papers are in high-impact factor journals such as The Lancet Infectious Diseases, The Lancet Regional Health-Southeast Asia, Seminars in Cancer Biology, etc. The total publications of the DPU is jumped to 3795. Apart from research publications, faculty members have contributed to various books in the form of book chapters and editors. The contribution to the World Health Organisation Blue book on Head and Neck Pathology is the most notable one.

**Citations and h index:** As per the Scopus database, the total citation received for the publications for December 2022 is 948 with h index of 9. The overall citations have been escalated to 12524 with h index of 62. These data suggest that the DPU is the youngest university with the fastest citations and h index growth rate. The DPU profile on IRINS is the testimony of these achievements <https://dpu.irins.org/>

**Collaborations:** The cell has established collaborations with various academic and research institutions, both national and international, to promote research and innovation. These collaborations provide opportunities for joint research projects, exchange programs, and academic partnerships. The DPU unit of UNESCO Chair in Bioethics, Haifa which was re-established on 12<sup>th</sup> of August 2022 under the new International Chair in Bioethics with WMA Association by the hands of Dr. Russell D'Souza, Head, Asia Pacific Region, Director, Dept. of Education, Australia, Melbourne.

**Undergraduate Research promotion:** DPU's initiatives to promote undergraduate research demonstrate the institution's commitment to creating a culture of research and innovations, fostering intellectual curiosity, and empowering the next generation of researchers and scholars. Under the guidance of faculty members, undergraduate students apply to various National research grant schemes such as ICMR-STC. A total of 46 ICMR-STC research projects are submitted for consideration and results are awaited.

**Conferences and Workshops:** The various constituent units have organized and participated in several conferences, workshops, and seminars to promote research and development in different fields. Some of the notable workshops and seminars include "Molecular Genetics for Clinicians-Future", Guest lecture on post-tuberculosis interventions, Nuclear Medicine, etc.

**Proposed plans:** Applying to various Government Projects for strengthening the research component of DPU, which include DST-Purse. More focus on translational research with societal propositions.

Overall, the research and development cell of Dr. D. Y. Patil Vidyapeeth has been active and productive in the second half of 2022, and its achievements are a testament to the university's commitment to research and innovation.

### 3. Biotechnology Innovation Day

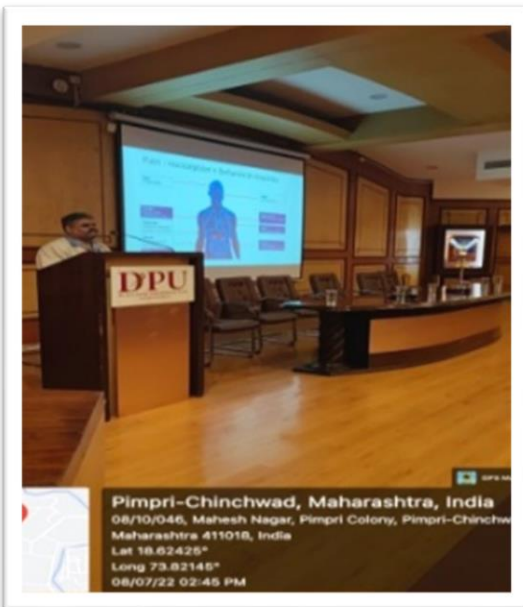

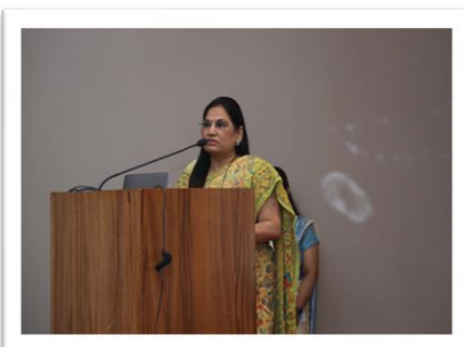

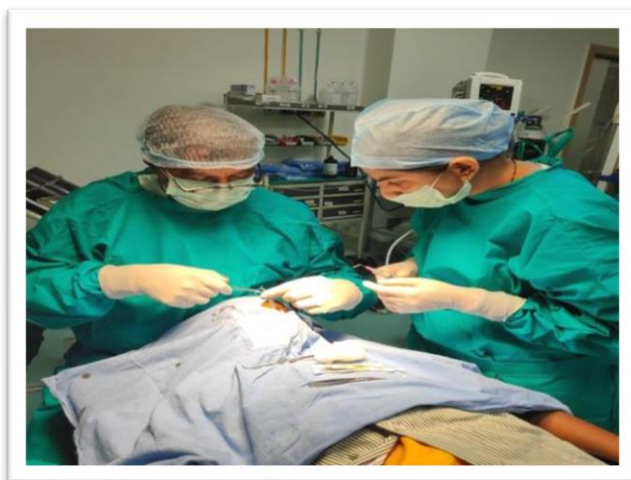


**3. Celebration of Geeta Jayanti - 6<sup>th</sup> December 2022**

The webinar was attended by teaching faculty and II BHMS Students, i.e., 74 participants of which were 21 male and 53 female.

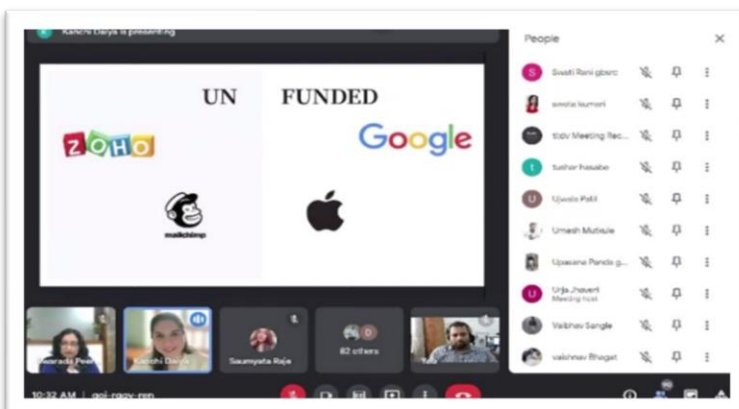

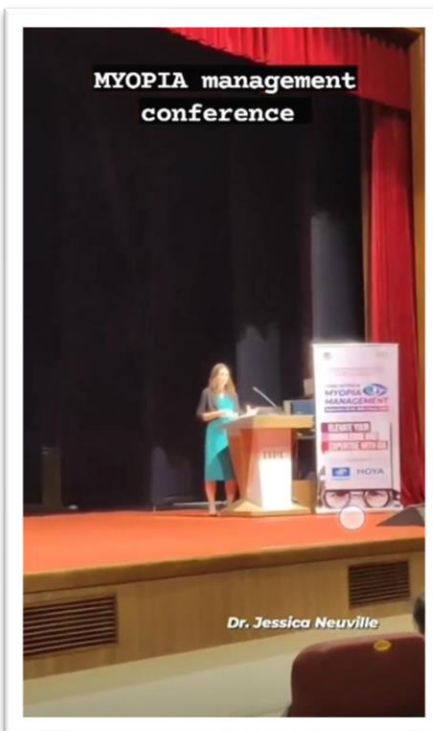

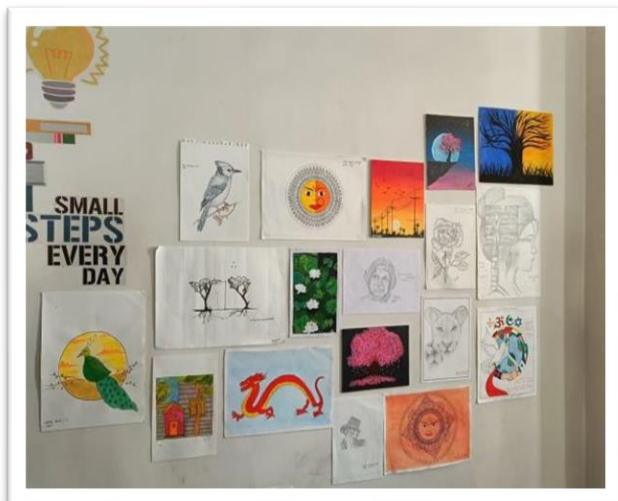
1 **National Chemistry Week**

### 2 Elocution Competition

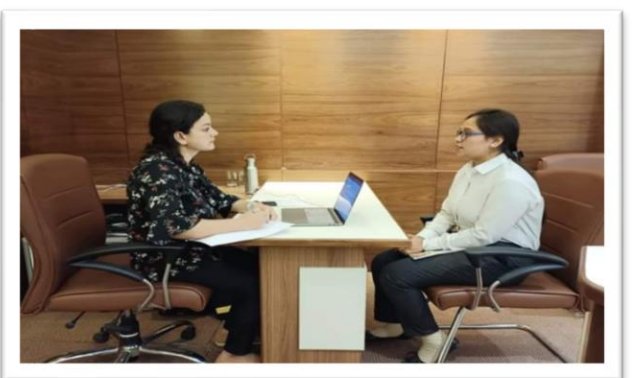
Day and Date: Thursday, 11<sup>th</sup> August 2022

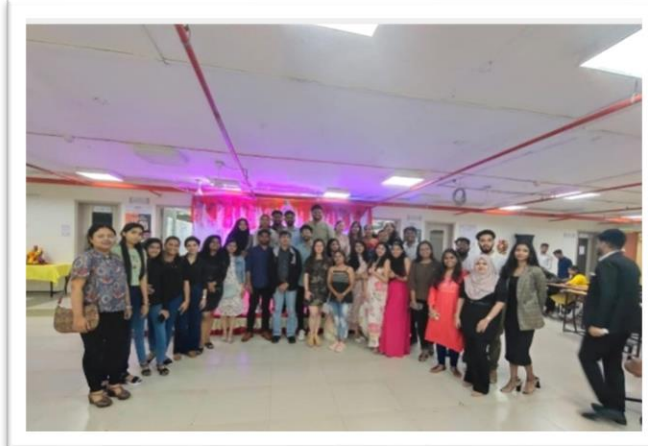

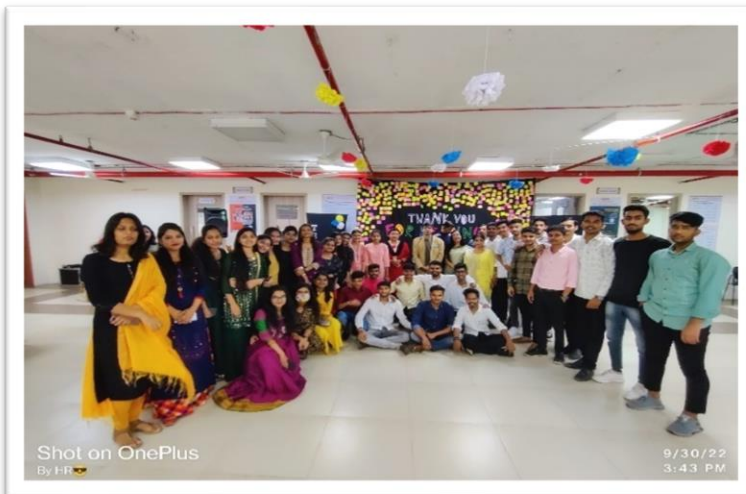

### 1 World AIDS Day

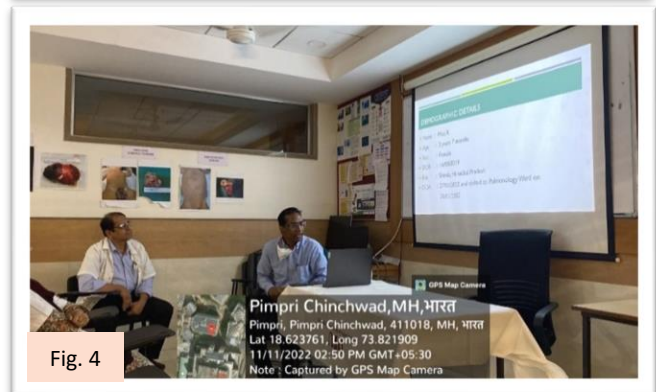
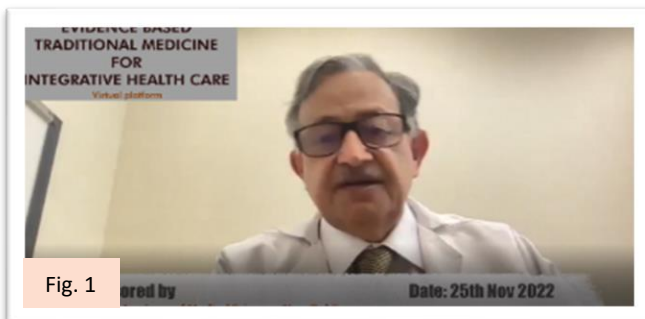
